**SUBJECT:** LSCO Presidential Search Update – May 2018

The search for the next president of Lamar State College – Orange continues to progress as scheduled.

The priority deadline for applications materials was May 18, 2018 and our executive search firm received a strong pool of high-quality candidates which is a good leading indicator for a successful search.

During June, 2018, the [presidential search advisory committee](#) will meet to confidentially review materials and interview interested candidates in order to narrow the pool to a small number of finalists.

The names of the presidential finalists will be publicly released. The finalists will be invited to LSCO, most likely during mid-July, to participate in open forums with faculty, staff, students, and members of the community. Feedback will be gathered from these sessions and shared with the Chancellor.

Chancellor Brian McCall will also interview the finalists during this time period, after which a sole finalist will be named by the Chancellor and recommended for confirmation by the system Board of Regents.

The new president is scheduled to begin in August/September, 2018.
