Continuing The Principles of Accreditation!

The <u>Principles of Accreditation: Foundations for Quality</u> <u>Enhancement</u> includes standards and requirements that apply to all programs and services within an institution.

Section 5: Administration & Organization 5.1 [CR], 5.2.a

The CEO of the institution is responsible for board approved missions, goals, and priorities. SACSCOC (2018) states, "CEO oversees an organizational structure that includes key academic and administrative officers and decision makers with credentials appropriate to their respective responsibilities" (pg. 34).

Section 5: Administration & Organization

5.2.c, 5.3

Successful fund raising can be a foundation to an institution's achievement of their mission. Therefore, the institution's CEO is in control of the fund raising to support the institutional priorities and initiatives. It is common for colleges to create or have an affiliation with independent, separately incorporated entities, like the LSC-O Foundation. Clearly defined authority and operating controls should be established in a formal, written manner.

5.4, 5.5

To ensure institutions have effective leadership to be successful with its mission, appropriate academic and administrative officers are employed to uphold responsibilities associated with their positions. SACSCOC (2018) says that, "There is an expectation that an institution consistently follows it own policies" (pg. 41). Institutions issue policies explaining conditions of appointment, employment, and evaluation to demonstrate that they employ personnel with adequate qualifications to support the achievement of goals with the educational mission.
