Section 6: Faculty

6.1 [CR]

To achieve the institution's mission, a full-time faculty is required to supply direction to the academic programs. The quantity of the faculty needs to be adequate to satisfy functions of the college. SACSCOC (2018) states, "Consequently, an institution relies on full-time faculty engagement in all aspects of the academic program," (pg. 43).

Faculty members direct the learning system of the academic institution, it is important that the institution maintains an effective system for appointing, discontinuing, evaluating, and continuing its faculty members. SACSCOC (2018) says that, "Appropriately approved processes should be in place and the institution should be able to show it consistently follows its own policies and procedures" (pg. 51).

6.2.a,b,c

It is essential to have qualified and effective members of the faculty to be successful in the institution's mission and to ensure program quality and integrity. There is an expectation when offering specific academic programs, that sufficient faculty resources will be provided for those programs. Student learning is important to the institutional mission, so the faculty has responsibility for overseeing and coordinating programs to assure they contain essential curricular components, correct content and instruction, and maintain disciplinary actions.
