ACADEMIC PROBATION



A student is placed on academic probation when their overall grade point average (GPA) at the end of a semester drops below an average of a 2.0.

Academic probation is divided between two levels.

P1: Level 1 Academic Probation	P2: Level 2 Academic Probation
Class registration is limited to 12 credit hours.	 Class registration is limited to 7 credit hours.
Receive a good academic ● standing when your overall GPA is above a 2.0.	 Receive a good academic standing when your overall GPA is above a 2.0.
• Removal of probation limits if GPA remains above a 2.0.	• Transfer to P1 probation if your Term GPA is above a 2.0.
• Transfer to P2 probation if your GPA remains below a 2.0.	• Withdraw one semester of study if your Term GPA is below a 2.0.
